MDSC REPRESENTATIVE JOB DESCRIPTION

The Metropolitan Detroit Ski Council Representative is the club spokesperson at all MDSC meetings. As spokesperson, this person votes on any council matters the way that will be in the club's best interest. Also, the MDSC Representative communicates all information between the MDSC and the club which benefits both organizations. This communication includes, but is not limited to: various offers, discounts and coupons through the MDSC to be made available to the club membership; matters of order which affect any of the clubs committees; any MDSC activities which are made available to the club. Communicating MDSC information to club members should be done by submitting articles to the club newsletter for publication. During the months of September through April, the MDSC meets twice monthly (on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday), and once a month (on the 1st Tuesday) during the months of May through August.
